

Access to Kamfers Dam

Kamfers Dam's flamingos can be seen from the small viewing area which can be accessed via the subway under the railway line (adjacent to the R28 Kimberley-Warrenton) road. At times the subway can be flooded.

There are two information boards about (a) Kamfers Dam and (b) Lesser Flamingos at the subway.

It should be noted that not only is it dangerous, but it is also an offence to walk on the railway line. In order to access the railway line, prior permission has to be obtained from Spoornet.

In some circumstances, permission may be obtained to gain access to Kamfers Dam via an alternative, locked, entrance. Information can be obtained from Mark Anderson.

It is hoped that in the not too distant future, better access will be provided (hides, viewing platform, etc.) to enable bird-watchers and other ecotourists the opportunity to view the wonderful spectacle of Kamfers Dam's flamingos

There are also currently plans to install a webcam on the Dam's flamingo breeding island.
